
## Sprinter MY2019 Disconnect main battery

In the needs to disconnect the main battery power, please ensure to do one of the following:

- Disconnect battery ground, shown in Picture 1
- Remove the battery connector pole, shown in Picture 2

If the main battery needs to be disconnected for more than an hour, please remove fuse 32 located in the driver fuse box, shown in Picture 3.

Note: If the above steps are not followed, the emergency battery will continue to provide power to the ignition unit.
